ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT BAHA'I ACTIVITIES

July 22, 2002

Dearly co-workers

I respectfully submit the report of the activities being held in the area of Tagpait, Aborlan, Palawan from July to September, 2001.

ACTIVITIES

I. Children's Class

The first batch of Children's Class was established in July 7, 2001 in Barangay Tagpait, Aborlan, Palawan, attended by 16 children of which, 4 males and 12 females. Through the suggestions raised by the children and permitted by their parents, classes were held regularly, every Saturday and Sunday. Using the 15 Lessons in the Ruhi Book 3, the class completed the lessons last September 16, 2001.

As part of its extracurricular activities, the book entitled "Udoy", a story and coloring book, by Mrs. Jane T. Urbanek was taught and explained to the children. Mrs. Jane T. Urbanek generously donated 11 of such books and 10 boxes of crayons for the children's class.

Moreover, Mr. Rollie Rivera facilitated tie dyeing workshop using old shirts and other clothing upon completion of the book "Udoy". The first batch graduated last October 13, 2001 at barangay Tagpait, Aborlan, Palawan.

II. Fireside

Fireside was held in Barangay Tagpait, Aborlan last July 29, 2001 hosted by Ailyn G. Randolph. The event was attended by 47 individuals both believers and non-believers, of which, (21 were children, 8 were youths and 18 were adults). There are about 14 Baha'i friends from Princess Urduja, LSA of Gogognan, and San Juan who attended the event. Mr. Wilfredo Pineda was asked to explain the Faith and its teachings, show some pictures of the Vineyard of the Lord, and the Baha'i Temples. Mr. Marcelino Manzano Jr. was asked to present and explain the Progressive Revelation and Mr. Dominador Manzano asked to explain the Baha'i Principles. Some Baha'i friends gave additional explanation about the Faith.

After the presentation, audience was encourage to asked questions to give more understanding about the Faith. Only few were raised their hands to ask questions. Out of the number of the audiences who heard the Beauty of the teachings of the Faith, there is only one who received His bounty at that moment and full of excitement to enroll and sign up the Baha'i card. It is no other than Mrs. Dina Doncina Gayoc, who has 4 children and owner of a small sari-sari store in the area.

III. Study Circle (Ruhi Book - I)

Study Circle (Ruhi Book I) was started last August 10 and ended September 2, 2001 in Tagpait, Aborlan, Palawan. The study circle took about 10 consecutive nights and 2 consecutive day time for about 2 ^{1/2} hours each meeting. The study was facilitated by Mr. Dominador Manzano, youth from Princess Urduja, Narra who gave his unselfish effort in order to help the children, youths and adult in the area, who are willing the hear the Beauty of the Faith.

There are about 10 participants who successfully completed the course and 3 of them sincerely enrolled in the Baha'i community after completion. The following is a list of the participants who attended the study.

IV. Nineteen Day Feasts

- A. The "Feast of Names" was celebrated last August 19, 2001 at 7:30 in the evening in Barangay Tagpait, Aborlan. Fortunately, this was the first Feast held in the area, and was attended by 15 individuals of which (5 were children, 5 were youths, and 5 were adults). Out of this number 5 Bahai's are untiringly facilitated the celebration.

On the devotional part of the celebration, opening prayers, reciting of the hidden words and reading from the writings of Baha'u'llah and Abdu'l-Baha were given. Since the locality has no Assembly as of yet, the second part was purely deepening, consultation and planning of activities in the area. The last part was the socialization, in which drinks and food were served to the visitors. Children are full of excitement while singing and dancing. Closing prayer.

- B. The "Feast of Might", the second Feast held in the area was celebrated in the evening of September 7, 2001. This celebration was attended by 18 individuals of which (8 children, 5 youths, and 5 adults). On the first part of the Feast, children offered prayers and quotations; and youths, readings of the writings of Baha'u'llah and Abdu'l-Baha and in the second part deepening and planning. Closing prayer. The last part is socialization. Food and drinks were served, film viewing and singing and dancing of children.

V. Other activities

- A. Devotional Meetings

Devotional meetings began in September 16, 2001 (Sunday). The meeting contained prayers, study of the writings and quotations, and deepening. Friends during the consultation at every feast agreed this activity. The purpose is to deepen new believers and to attract more believers who along the way observe how the Baha'is gather and what the Faith teaches. The activity will be held either at Baha'i homes or outdoor places. Friends can invite their friends to attend the said activity.

B. Conduct children's class at Aborlan Central Elementary School. This activity started when some teachers in the said school request to conduct the activity
